

Collective Worship News

All primary schools have a daily assembly; this can be as a whole school, a key stage or a year group. In a Church of England school this is known as Collective Worship. We look at a range of topics, issues and focus on our school values - this is done always with a link to the Christian faith. A prayer is said in all acts of Collective Worship; prayer is invitational, meaning all are required to respectfully listen and if the individual wishes to agree / participate, they can say 'amen' at the end of the prayer.
