Non-Prescription Medication

I wanted to make you aware of an upcoming change to our medicines policy. Currently we do not accept or administer any medication to children, unless it is prescribed by a doctor. **We will now administer non-prescription (over the counter) medicines.**

When you bring a non-prescription medication into school for your child, the same protocols as prescription medication apply:

- You will need to bring the medication to the office and complete a form.
- The medication must be in date and in it's original packaging, with the instruction leaflet included.
- You will need to inform us of when your child has last had a dose of medication.

Whilst we would prefer a parent/guardian to administer non-prescription medication, I understand that this is not always possible.
