Relationship and Sex Education coverage:

Year 2 – Growing and changing

In this unit your child will learn about life cycles. They will learn:

- How to give positive feedback to others
- Recognise the range of feelings that are associated with losing (and being reunited) with a person they are close to
- Identify different stages of growth (e.g. baby, toddler, child, teenager, adult)
- Understand and describe some of the things that people are capable of at these different stages
- Identify which parts of the human body are private
- Explain that a person's genitals help them to make babies when they are grown up
- That humans mostly have the same body parts but that they can look different from person to person
- That you are not allowed to touch someone's private belongings without their permission
- Concepts of basic first-aid, for example dealing with common injuries, including head injuries and how to make an emergency call
