National Assessments 2021

It has been in the press over the last few days about the amendments to national testing and I would like to update you about what this means for primary schools:

- Year 1 Phonics screening check is going ahead.
- Year 2 SATs have been cancelled—assessment will be teacher assessment only.
- Year 4 timestables check remains non-statutory for another year. Our children will participate as we did in the first year of the pilot.
- Year 6 SATS will go ahead; however there will be no Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Test.
