The Inclusive Classroom

This school year the teaching team, led by Mrs Aldous (SENCO), have built a bank of resources to support and advise parents on SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities). These resources are available on our [school website](#).

The way in which we teach at Hartwell allows children to develop as learners so that all children can make good progress, irrespective of additional need. The Education Endowment Foundation provides evidence based research, which is what we base much of our teaching strategy on. Their guidance report on SEND focuses on how high quality classroom teaching, particularly through metacognitive approaches and reducing cognitive overload, supports pupils with SEND to learn and make good progress. It also details that good teaching practises in the classroom for children with SEND are good for all pupils, therefore should be part of habitual teaching practice. This is the approach that we take.

As it is the end of the school year, teachers have completed the final assessments and it is a joy to see the clear evidence that children in our school with SEND make progress which is aligned with their peers.

Heat Health
